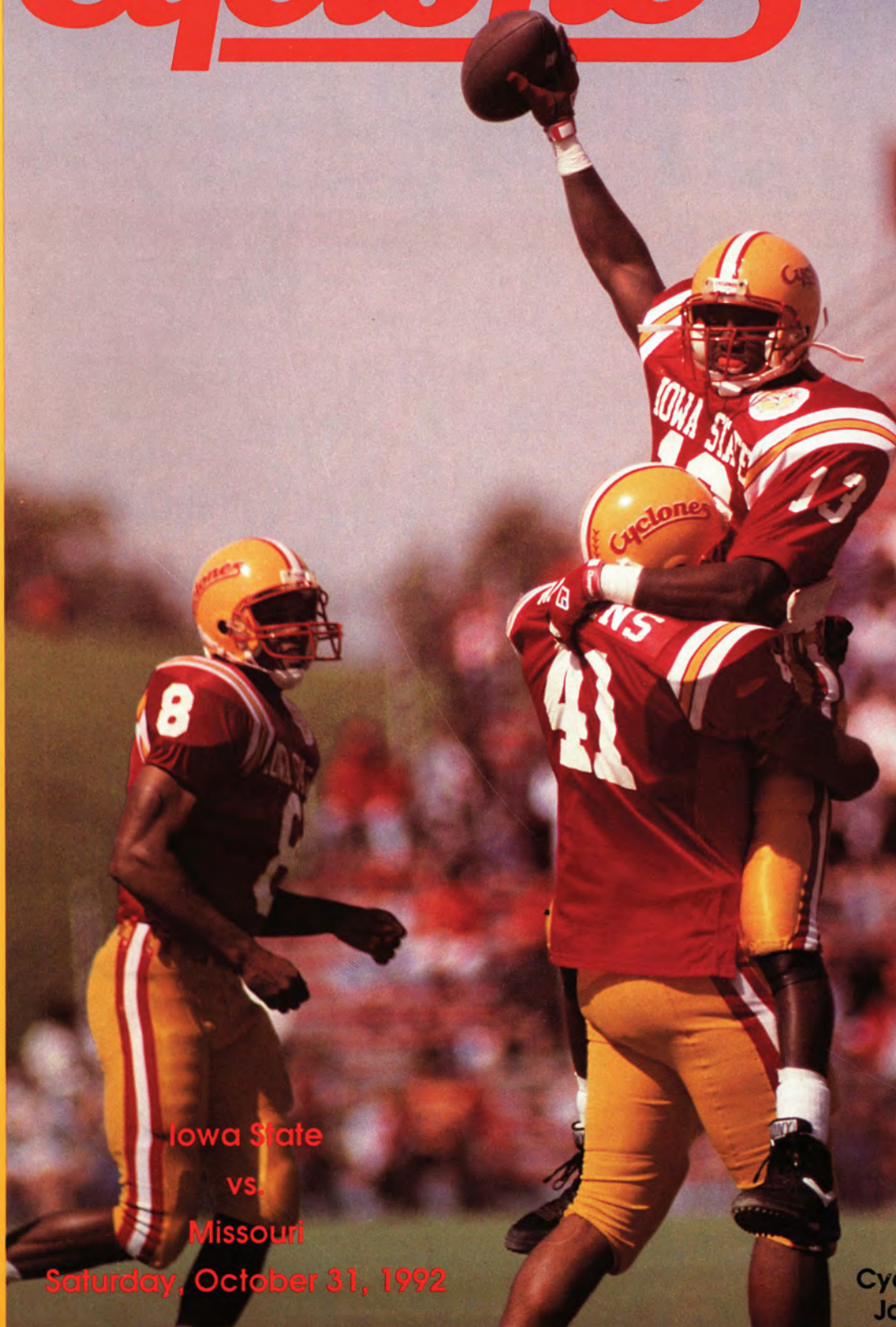
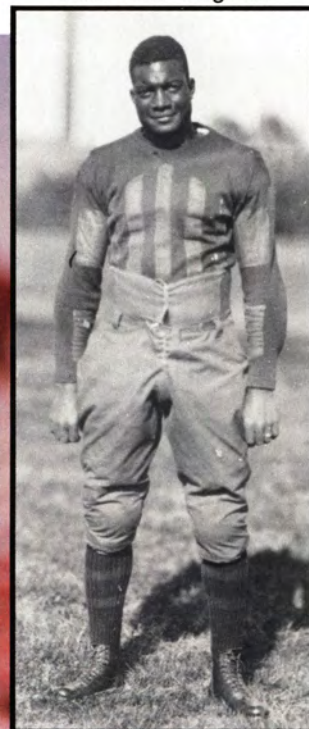

This Is Iowa State

Since the first students enrolled at Iowa State, the institution has been committed to academic excellence. Iowa State's reputation for scholarship is internationally known and Iowa State's students are respected nationwide as serious scholars.

Iowa State offers its students some of the most advanced academic, athletic, cultural and social opportunities in the Midwest.

Iowa State University was founded in 1858 under terms of the Land Grant College Act signed by President Abraham Lincoln during the Civil War. Since the beginning, Iowa State has been a co-educational "people's college." As years passed, the University developed a reputation as an outstanding broad-based institution with academic emphasis in the humanities and the arts, while maintaining its position in the scientific and technical fields. Recently, Iowa State has become known as a leading research center, renowned in the fields of engineering and agriculture.

One of the largest institutions governed by the State Board of Regents, Iowa State is a major Midwestern center of learning for more than 25,000 students, from all 50 states and more than 100 other nations. Iowa State attracts a diverse student body with a wide range of undergraduate and graduate programs with a student to teaching faculty ratio of 18. More than 120 undergraduate programs of study are available from Iowa State's eight colleges: Agriculture, Business, Design, Education, Engineering, Family and Consumer Sciences, Liberal Arts and Sciences and Veterinary Medicine.

The picturesque campus is comfortably situated in a central campus "park" - with a splendid combination of conventional and contemporary architecture. ISU's classrooms and buildings are a blend of the old and new, nestled amid thousands of trees and acres of greenery. The

modern south campus is dominated by the Iowa State Center, Cyclone Stadium-Jack Trice Field, and the College of Veterinary Medicine.

The Iowa State Center, which boasts one of the nation's finest facilities of its kind, consists of the C.Y. Stephens Auditorium, the J.W. Fisher Theater, the

Scheman Continuing Education Center, and the James H. Hilton Coliseum. Concert facilities draw some of the top names in entertainment. Bruce Springsteen, Tina Turner, Bill Cosby, the Rolling Stones, Paul McCartney, Billy Joel, and the Broadway hit "Cats" have been featured on campus.

One of the highlights of the year occurs in spring as the campus blooms with tulips and apple blossoms just in time for the Veishea celebration. "Veishea" is ISU's annual open house and the largest student-run festival in the nation, complete with parade, exhibits and thousands of alumni. The campus is also a breathtaking sight in the fall, when autumn colors and leaves make it a cardinal and gold show place.

Sports are a vital part of the life at Iowa State. The Department of Intercollegiate Athletics offers 21 men's and women's sports and the extensive intramural program boasts one of the highest student participation rates in the country. A number of Cyclone intercollegiate teams have been nationally ranked in recent years and several have brought home national titles. Iowa State also has produced 24

Olympians, three of whom captured gold medals.

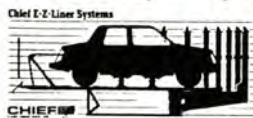

Cyclones and Tigers Tangle in Big Eight Showdown

Neither Iowa State head coach Jim Walden nor Missouri's Bob Stull should have any trouble motivating their respective squads for today's game. Both teams are winless in Big Eight play and are hungry to escape the conference cellar.

After compiling 516 yards of total offense against Kansas on Oct. 17, Iowa State's offense sputtered last weekend at Oklahoma State, committing eight turnovers in a 27-21 loss. The Cyclones led 7-0 after a 91-yard punt return for touchdown by James McMillion early in the first quarter. ISU was dealt a major blow when quarterback Bob Utter suffered a concussion while forcing Oklahoma State cornerback Dmitri Markham out-of-bounds, after the Cowboy intercepted Utter's pass with 11:35 left in the second quarter.

Trailing 27-7 in the fourth quarter, the Cyclones rallied with two scoring drives capped by touchdown runs of 1- and 2-yards by backup quarterback

Donnie Smith.

Smith and Marvin Seiler combined for 12 completions in 22 attempts for 111 yards and two interceptions.

Seniorlinebacker Malcolm Goodwin led the ISU defense with 15 tackles against Oklahoma State. The Ames, Iowa, native is ranked among the nation's leaders in total tackles and tackles per game. He leads the team with 102 tackles in seven games, an average of 14.6 per game.

Fourth-year Tiger head coach Bob Stull will be looking for his first-ever victory over the Cyclones. Iowa State has won the

last four meetings between the two schools, but will face Missouri quarterback Jeff Handy, who has completed 72 passes for 904 yards and five touchdowns in the last two weeks.

Handy turned in a stellar performance last week against Nebraska, but his 424-yard effort was not enough as the Huskers handed the Tigers a 34-24 Homecoming loss in Columbia. Handy's 424 passing yards was the most ever yielded by Nebraska. The sophomore, who passed for 480 yards vs. Oklahoma State two weeks ago, is the first quarterback in Big Eight history to throw for over 400 yards in back-to-back games.

With his six points against Nebraska, Jeff Jacke became the leading kick scorer in Missouri history. His 193 career points broke Tom Whelihan's mark of 191, set during the 1984-87 seasons.

Missouri ranks ninth nationally in passing offense with an average of 295.4 yards per game and 33rd in total offense. However, MU is 103rd in rushing offense with 93.3 yards per game.

The Tigers are looking to snap an eight-game road losing streak, dating back to a 31-21 victory at Kansas in 1990. Iowa State's current four-game winning streak against Mizzou is the Cyclones' longest in the series, which began in 1895. The last two ISU victories came by a total of three points. Missouri leads the series in Ames, 26-13-3, but haven't won at Cyclone Sta-

dium-Jack Trice Field since a 42-17 victory in 1987.

In recent years, the visiting team has fared better in the series. Iowa State's 27-25 win in 1990 broke a five-game losing streak against the Tigers in Ames.

Missouri leads the overall series, 48-28-9, but ISU has won the last four

games, including a 23-22 frigid win over the Tigers in Columbia.

On the coldest football Saturday in Columbia since 1950, Iowa State took a 7-0 lead on Kevin Caldwell's touchdown run. Caldwell, who ended the day with a season-high 154 yards rushing, scored ISU's first touchdown in over a month. A 26-yard field goal by Ty Stewart gave ISU a 10-0 first quarter advantage. Jacke's 44-yard field goal put the Tigers on the board 10-3. His 33-yard boot narrowed the margin to 10-6; However, Ty Stewart's 38-yarder with 3:08 remaining in the first half put ISU ahead 13-6.

Mizzou mounted a drive, capped off by Phil Johnson's 14-yard strike to Ken Dunn, to tie the game 13-13 going into the intermission.

Stewart's 43-yard field goal, his longest of the season thus far, with 3:32 in the third quarter put the Cyclones ahead, 16-13. ISU increased its lead to 23-13 on Jim Knott's 14-yard touchdown run. Jacke capped off a 14-play, 80-yard drive with a 33-yard field goal to pull the Tigers within a touchdown. Johnson's 3-yard strike to Kenny Holly pulled MU within one point, 23-22. However, Weylan Harding intercepted Johnson's 2-point conversion attempt to give the Cyclones their fourth straight win over the Tigers.

Martin C. Jischke

President—Iowa State University



When Martin Jischke became Iowa State University's 13th president on June 1, 1991, he brought to ISU an impressive record of administrative service and scholarly achievement spanning nearly 25 years.

In his first year as president of ISU, enrollment increased and research funding topped a record \$100 million. Private fund-raising also set a record last year as the Partnership for Prominence capital campaign reached its \$150 million goal a year early and a new goal of \$185 million was set for June 30, 1993.

From 1986 to 1991, Dr. Jischke was chancellor of the University of Missouri, Rolla. Under his leadership, enrollment, sponsored research funding, private fund raising and technology transfer efforts all increased significantly.

Dr. Jischke was a faculty member and administrator at the University of Oklahoma, Norman, for 17 years, serving as dean of the College of Engineering from 1981 to 1986, interim president in 1985, director and professor of the School of Aerospace, Mechanical and Nuclear Engineering from 1977 to 1981, and professor of aerospace, mechanical and

nuclear engineering from 1968 to 1975.

He received a B.S. in physics, with honors, in 1963 from

the Illinois Institute of Technology, Chicago, and a master's degree in 1964 and a Ph.D. degree in 1968 in aeronautics and astronautics from the Massa-

chusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge. He is trained as a fluid dynamicist and has expertise in heat transfer, fluid mechanics, aerodynamics, and problems related to high-speed aircraft and spacecraft.

He was a research fellow for NASA at Moffett Field in the summer of 1973, a research fellow at the Donald W. Douglas Laboratory in the summer of 1971, and a research engineer at the Battelle Northwest Laboratory in the summer of 1970.

From 1975 to 1976, he was a White House Fellow and Special Assistant to the Secretary of Transportation in the U.S. Department of Transportation with a special emphasis in the area of automobile safety.

Dr. Jischke is the author or co-author of 31 archival journal publications, 21 major technical reports and the co-editor of one book. He has received research grants from the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Air Force, NASA, the National Institutes of Health, the National Severe Storms Laboratory and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

He is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and an Associate Fellow of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics. He is listed in "Who's Who in America," "Who's Who in Engineering," "American Men and Women of Science" and "Outstanding Educators of America."

Dr. Jischke and his wife, Patty, have two children, Charles 15, and Mary, 11. Patty Jischke earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in social work in 1970, Master of Library of Sciences degree in 1971 and the Juris Doctorate in 1975 from the University of Oklahoma. She is a member of the Oklahoma Bar Association.

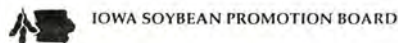

Jim Walden

Iowa State Head Coach

Nearly six years ago, Iowa State University began the search for a football coach. The Cyclones were looking for a new direction, a new personality and a new attitude for the Iowa State program. ISU found all of those ingredients in Jim Walden, and on December 16, 1986, the former Washington State mentor became Iowa State's 28th head football coach.

The personable native of Aberdeen, Mississippi arrived at ISU with "no magic formulas," just a promise to "come in here and do the best I can and to work as hard as I know how." Walden proved to be a man of his word, bringing greater success both on and off the field to each of his Cyclone squads.

His first ISU team finished 3-8-0 and demonstrated consistent improvement throughout the season. His 1988 unit improved to 5-6-0 and challenged for a winning season. The Cyclones finished fifth in the Big Eight Conference.

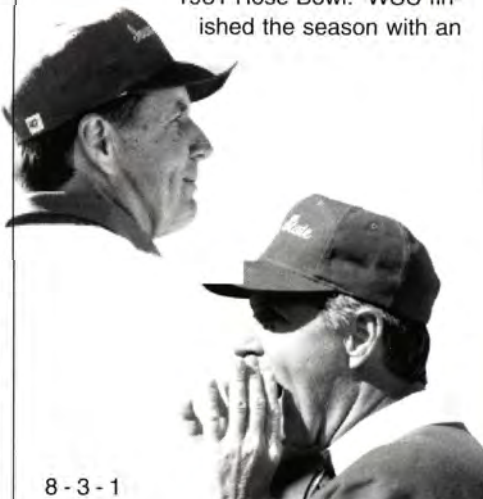
The third time proved to be a charm. Walden's 1989 squad went 6-5 for the school's first winning season under his direction. ISU's 4-1 road record was its best since 1978. Iowa State ended the year ranked among the nation's top 25 teams in rushing and total offense.

In 1990, Walden guided the Cyclones to fourth-place finish in the Big Eight, a conference that featured national powerhouses Colorado, Oklahoma and Nebraska. ISU also defeated the Sooners for the first time since 1961.

As the head coach at Washington State for nine years, Walden compiled a 44-52-4 record against tough Pacific 10 Conference competition. During that time, Walden guided the Cougars to three winning seasons and four first-division conference finishes.

The 54-year-old Walden was at Washington State for 10 years, first serving as an assistant to Warren Powers. When Powers left WSU following the 1977 season, Walden was tabbed as his replacement and began building the Washington

State program. The culmination of a four-year plan came when Walden took the Cougars to the 1981 Holiday Bowl, WSU's first bowl appearance since the 1931 Rose Bowl. WSU finished the season with an

m a r k ,
needing only a win in the regular-season finale to go to the Rose Bowl.

Walden's success did not go unnoticed by his peers. He earned Pac-10 Coach-of-the-Year honors in 1981 and 1983. In 1981, he was the UPI West and AFCA/Kodak District IX Coach-of-the-Year. Following the 1981 season, he was asked to be an assistant coach for the West squad in the Japan Bowl and at the East-West Shrine Game that year. He was the head coach of the victorious West squad in the 1985 East-West Shrine Game, and was an assistant at the 1986 Hula Bowl.

Despite spending 10 years in the Pac-10, Walden came to ISU familiar with Big Eight Conference football. He started his collegiate coaching career in 1969 at Nebraska under his former college coach, Bob Devaney. For the next four seasons, Walden was a defensive coach for the Cornhuskers. During those years Nebraska won two national championships.



From Nebraska, Walden moved to Miami (Fla.) in 1973 as an offensive backfield coach for Pete Elliott, and was later named defensive coordinator under Carl Selmer. Walden joined Powers' Washington State staff as backfield coach for the 1977 season.

As a collegiate quarterback at Wyoming, Walden guided the Cowboys to a pair of Skyline Conference titles. Following his college career, Walden signed with the British Columbia Lions of the Canadian Football League and coached Amory High School in his native Mississippi for five years before going to Nebraska.

An excellent speaker, Walden is in demand for outside engagements. The NCAA has selected him twice as a guest speaker at its annual College Football Preview, in 1983 and 1985. Since coming to ISU, he's become a popular figure with

Scouting Report

The Series: Missouri holds a 48-28-9 advantage in the series with Iowa State. Last year in Columbia, the Cyclones won 23-22. ISU quarterback Kevin Caldwell rushed for 154 yards and one touchdown. Missouri quarterback Phil Johnson threw a three-yard touchdown to Kenny Holly to cut Iowa State's lead to 23-22 in the game's final seconds, but Cyclone Weylan Harding intercepted the two-point conversion attempt to secure the victory. ISU has won four straight against the Tigers.

Last Weekend: Missouri racked up 446 yards in a 34-24 loss to the eighth-rated Nebraska Cornhuskers in Columbia. The Tigers trailed 27-24 when quarterback Jeff Handy's pass was intercepted with 7:40 left in the game. Nebraska scored the clinching touchdown with 2:09 to play. Handy passed for 424 yards, the most ever yielded by a Nebraska defense. Handy threw touchdown passes to tight end A.J. Ofofiele for 13 yards and to wide receiver Victor Bailey for 39 yards. Bailey caught eight passes for 159 yards. It was the second week in a row that Handy has thrown for more than 400 yards.

Offensively: Handy, a sophomore from Blue Springs, Mo., has completed 104-of-173 passes for 1,343 yards and seven touchdowns. He passed for 904 yards and five touchdowns in the past two games. Wide receivers Victor Bailey and Kenny Holly are moving up the Tiger receiving charts. Bailey, a senior, has caught 41 passes for 706 yards this season. He is currently fourth in career receptions and second in career receiving yards at Missouri. Holly, a junior, has caught 43 passes for 478 yards this season. He ranks ninth in career receptions and seventh in season receptions. Missouri is averaging

388 yards of total offense per game.

Defensively: Senior strong safety Maurice Benson is leading the Tigers in tackles with 49. He has two tackles for a loss of 12 yards. Sophomores Travis McDonald and Jerome Madison have 44 tackles each. Missouri has caused five fumbles and has recovered four. Montana Waggoner and Kevin McIntosh, sophomore defensive backs, lead the team in interceptions with two each. Missouri is allowing their opponents 418 yards of total offense per game.

Kicking: Sophomore Kyle Pooler is the punter for the Tigers. The native of Phoenix, Ariz. has punted 27 times for an average of 39 yards per kick. His longest punt of the season is 71 yards. Pooler is also the backup placekicker to Jeff Jacke. Jacke, a senior from Richardson, Texas, leads the Tigers in scoring with 38 points. He is 14-of-15 on extra point attempts. Jacke is 8-of-14 on field goal attempts with a long of 51 yards.

The Coach: Head coach Bob Stull is 10-29-1 in his fourth year at Missouri. Stull, a 1968 graduate of Kansas State, has an overall record of 41-56-1. Stull was captain of the Kansas State football team in 1967. He was a three-year letterwinner as a Wildcat. The Davenport, Iowa, native was the head coach at Massachusetts from 1984-1985. He went on to coach at Texas-El Paso from 1986-1988. Stull's 1988 Miner team had a record of 10-3 and played in the Independence Bowl.

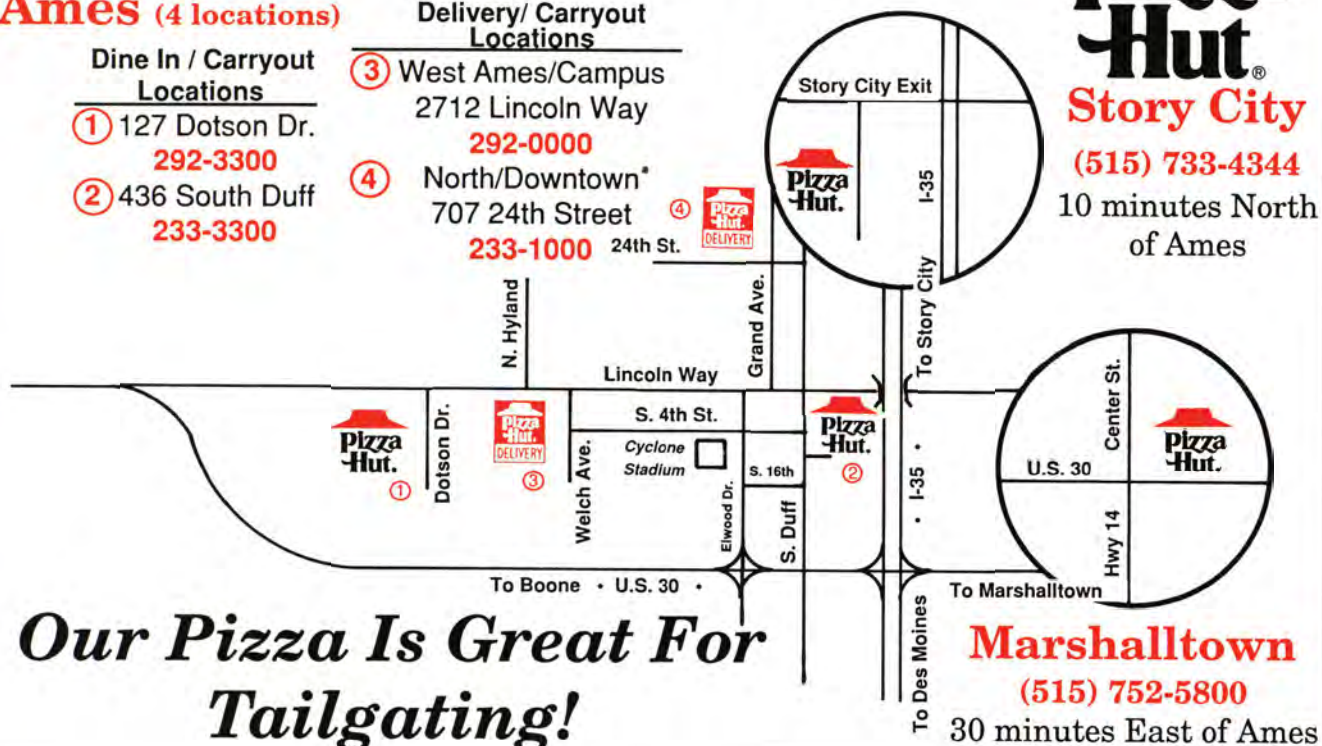

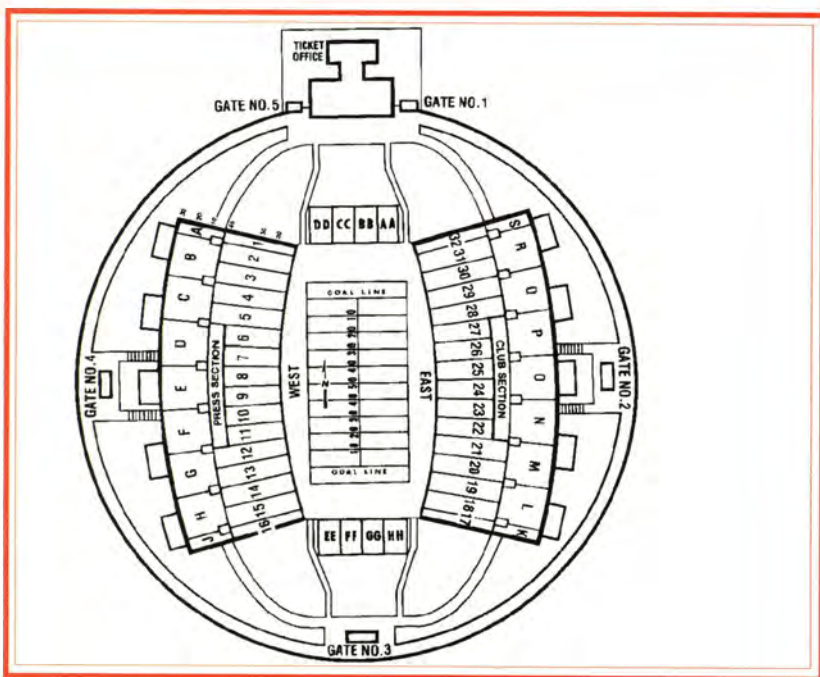

Stadium Information



First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact the nearest usher to request medical assistance.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked at the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be stamped for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-admission. No pass outs will be allowed between noon and 1 p.m. or one hour before kickoff.

Service for Physicians

Doctors anticipating calls during the game are urged to register at the first aid quarters under the west stands, leaving their exact seat location. The management will see that all calls are delivered without delay.

Lost and Found

A lost and found service is maintained in the Athletic Ticket Office in the Olsen Building at the north end of the stadium. Articles found should be turned over to an usher or left at the Athletic Ticket Office.

Public Telephone

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands.

Refreshments

Refreshments are served in the stands and at locations around the stadium.

Iowa State Souvenirs

An attractive array of Iowa State souvenirs is available at conveniently located novelty sales booths throughout the stadium and from vendors in the parking areas.

Special Medical Needs

Individuals with specific medical needs may request a waiver from the ISU Business Office, Bill Goldring, room 137 Olsen Building, 294-4930.

Coolers, Thermoses, Chairs Discouraged

As a courtesy to neighboring ticket holders, spectators are asked not to bring stadium chairs, coolers or thermoses into the stands.

Rest Rooms

Rest rooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Public Address System

No appeals will be made over the public address system except under special circumstances. The public is asked not to request this service.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 16, 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts.

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium any bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tis-

sue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team.

The State of Iowa code prohibits the use of alcohol in the Stadium. The Athletic Department asks our patrons to behave responsibly and in compliance with the State code.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located in strategic spots throughout the stadium parking area.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. Signs are to be displayed on the south end of the Olsen Building and on the walls of the stands, both upper and lower decks. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Iowa State's Athletic Department. For sign approval, see Dave Cox, 129 Olsen Building, before noon on Friday prior to the home games. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Emergency Road Service

Iowa State University and Iowa AAA Motor Club will provide an Emergency Road Service for persons attending home football games. This service will be in effect during and within two hours after the game throughout the season. The phone number for the service is 233-6636. Proof of game attendance (i.e.; ticket stub) may be requested.

Distractions

We want to make football Saturday a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage you to be respectful of those around you in the stadium. This attitude of cooperation can help to insure a pleasant enthusiastic game atmosphere. In the event you feel there is unreasonable distraction in your seating area, we ask you to take the following steps to help us control undesirable behavior:

—Note the seating section, row and seat numbers, and inform the usher in your section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and request it to stop, if appropriate.

—If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvement of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.

—An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation in next season's ticket assignment.

Cyclone Fans' Guide to NCAA Recruiting Regulations

Recently enacted NCAA regulations restrict recruiting assistance by those other than ISU staff assigned specifically to that duty.

A booster cannot initiate any type of contact with a prospect and/or family, nor render any type of financial support directly benefiting the family.

The following information may help provide insight into a few of the NCAA regulations and definitions by which coaches and other ISU representatives must comply.

Who is a booster?

A person who has/is a financial contributor to ISU athletics, has/is a promoter of the program, or has/is actively assisted in promoting ISU to a prospect is considered a booster, and ALWAYS maintains that identity. This title changes to an ISU athletic representative when a booster tries to interest an athlete in ISU, even if the university is not aware of the effort. A representative's actions are then judged by the same NCAA restrictions and guidelines as the coach.

Who is a prospect?

An athlete who has started the NINTH GRADE, and has been contacted by an institutional ISU representative. A booster could unknowingly be performing the role as representative, which could also change the status of the prospect to that of recruit.

Who is a recruit?

An athlete (or family/guardians) who has been solicited by representatives to enroll and participate in athletics is tabbed a recruit. This status exists when any contact other than a letter of inquiry to the athlete or normal courteous salutation occurs when accidentally encountering them.

What governs contacts?

Face-to-face encounters constitutes a contact if it exists beyond a cordial greeting. This also includes the recruit's family members. Further, any pre-arranged "bump" at the school, practice, or competition sites is a countable contact regardless of the dialogue or lack of it.

What contact limitations exist?

All sports are governed by calendered times for active recruiting. Other times are called quiet times when no personal contact is allowed. Representatives can evaluate an athlete four times plus have

three off-campus contacts as defined. Only tested and certified coaches can recruit off-campus. Representatives can initiate one telephone call per week to each recruit. However, recruits can call any representative as often as they desire.

When can contacts begin?

July 1 after a student's junior year.

How can ISU boosters help?

Coaches still need a network to help spot talent. The surest method of avoiding NCAA violations is to contact the ISU coach to advise him/her of the prospect. The coach can then inform the booster of the allowable roles. Boosters can obviously attend functions where the athlete is, but cannot have arranged not "accidental" contact promoting ISU. This extends to the family, the coach and other school personnel. Further, boosters are not allowed to obtain evaluative information from the school, such as academic records. No function can be hosted nor financed that intentionally and directly contributes to the recruit or family.

Cyclone Centennial Spotlight

Who Was Jack Trice?

(Iowa State football player Jack Trice died 67 years ago. The following is an excerpt from an article by Kevin Boone that appeared in the Sept./Oct. 1977 edition of *Black Collegian Magazine*.)

Jack Trice was born the son of Green and Anna Trice in 1902 in Hiram, Ohio. Trice attended East Tech High School in Cleveland and became a star athlete there. When his football coach, Sam Williaman, was named head coach at Iowa State, Trice and six other athletes followed him west.

On the gridiron, Trice was a stellar performer in the interior line. He played on the freshman team in 1922 and the following year was considered by many to be all-conference caliber. But the promising career abruptly ended. He finally got his chance in a game against Minnesota, considered the best in the conference that year. Iowa State was playing a strong defensive game that day and trailed by only four points, 14-10, at the half. It was during that time, Trice began to complain of a sore left shoulder, but nevertheless, returned to action in the second half. Midway through the third quarter, a frustrated Minnesota team ran a play off left tackle. Trice immediately

saw that he wouldn't be able to reach the ball carrier, so he threw himself in front of the Minnesota interference in a roll block. He was toppled over on his back and trampled on.

Trice wanted to continue playing but never returned to the game. According to newspaper accounts the crowd chanted, "We're sorry Ames, we're sorry." Doctors at a Minneapolis hospital allowed Trice to return to Ames with the team, which lost the game 20-17. They declared his condition not so serious. Trice rode back on a pullman coach. He rested his body on a straw mattress, and was immediately taken to the university hospital upon the train's arrival in Ames. There, doctors discovered a broken collarbone Trice had sustained during the first half of the contest. His condition worsened as he developed respiratory problems Sunday afternoon and a stomach specialist from Des Moines was summoned. Dr. Oliver Fay decided that surgery would be too risky, so no operation

was performed.

At 3 p.m. on Monday, October 8, 1923, Jack Trice was dead of hemorrhaged lungs and internal bleeding throughout the abdomen. The following Tuesday, classes were postponed and a funeral service was held before 4,000 students and faculty members on the central grounds of campus.

A letter written by Jack Trice to himself on the eve of the Minnesota game, was found in his coat pocket the day of his funeral. The contents of that letter were divulged before the 4,000 mourners. It read:

"My thoughts just before the first real college game of my life: The honor of my race, family and self is at stake. Everyone is expecting me to do big things. I will. My whole body and soul are to be thrown recklessly about the field. Every time the ball is snapped, I will be trying to do more than my part. Fight low, with your eyes open and toward the play. Watch out for crossbucks and reverse end runs. Be on your toes every minute if you expect to make good. Jack"

A memorial scholarship has been created, and a statue of Trice has been erected between Carver and Beardshear Halls on the ISU campus.

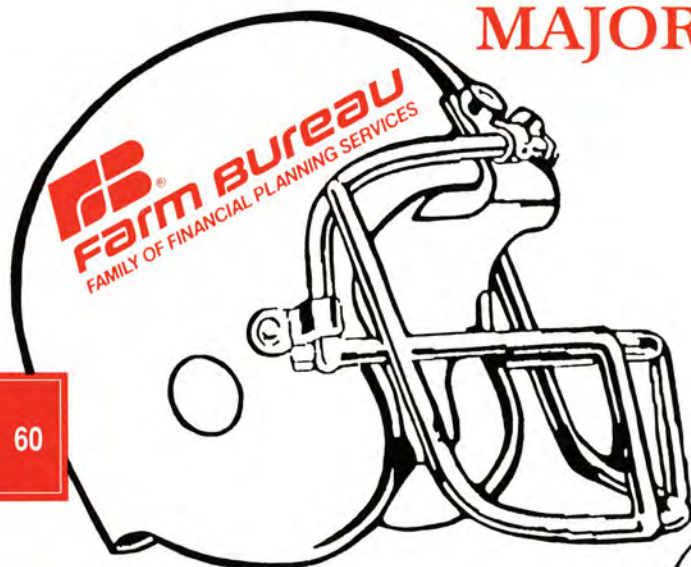

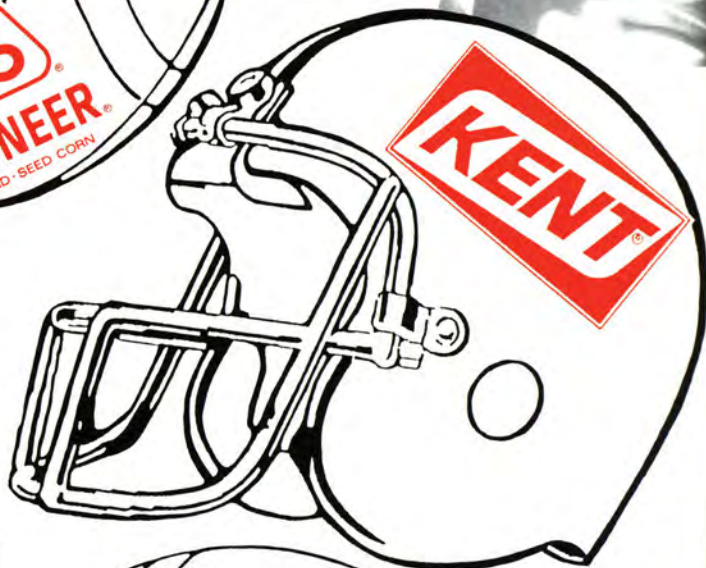
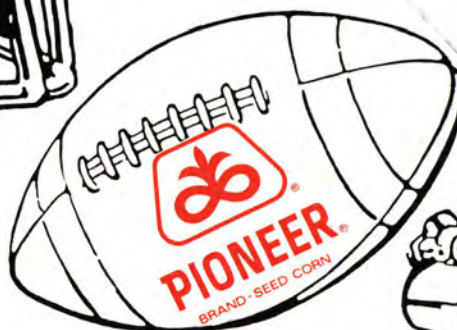
