

IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

Since it opened in 1858, Iowa State University has been working for the state of Iowa. As Iowa's land-grant university, Iowa State has played an important role in the educational, economic, cultural and social development of the state and the nation.

Both the Cooperative Extensive Service and agricultural experiment station system trace their beginnings to Iowa State University; the nation's first public school of veterinary medicine was established at Iowa State; and the electronic digital computer was invented at Iowa State.

Today, Iowa State University is a broad-based university of international stature. With more than 25,000 students from all 50 states and nearly 120 other nations, Iowa State is helping Iowa and the nation open doors to international exchange, trade and development.

Educating students for careers and lives in today's increasingly diverse and complex world remains Iowa State's highest priority. In recent years, Iowa State has been successful in attracting a more diverse student body and has expanded the number of opportunities for students to travel and learn in other countries.

Students at Iowa State can choose from among more than 100 programs of study leading to baccalaureate degrees in the colleges of Agriculture, Business, Design, Education, Engineering, Family and Consumer Sciences, and Liberal Arts and Sciences. The College of Veterinary Medicine offers the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree and graduate students can choose from among 200 fields of study leading to master's, doctor of philosophy and specialist degrees.

Students find a high quality of life when they become part of the Iowa State University community. An award-winning lectures program, nationally recognized residence hall

and Greek housing systems, a comprehensive array of student support services, and more than 400 student clubs and organizations were all reasons ISU was included in a recent national study of colleges and universities with a high quality of student life.

The Iowa State campus is recognized as one of the most beautiful in the nation. The park-like setting of 1,800 acres has more than 180 major buildings, including some beautifully restored structures from the late-1800s and early 1900s, as well as striking examples of modern architecture. Numerous pieces of art can be found throughout the campus, including sculptures by Christian Petersen and murals by Grant Wood.

The Iowa State Center on the south campus includes the 14,000-seat James H. Hilton Coliseum (where Cyclone men's and women's basketball, volleyball, gymnastics and wrestling teams compete), J.W. Fisher Theater, Scheman Continuing Education Building, and C.Y. Stephens Auditorium, hailed as one of the nation's finest concert halls. With these facilities, Iowa State regularly attracts headline entertainers and major international performing artists. Recently, Cyclone Stadium has played host to such notables as Genesis, the Rolling Stones, Paul McCartney, U2, Pink Floyd and the "Farm Aid '93" concert.

Athletics—both intramural and intercollegiate—play important roles in the life of Iowa State University. A member of the prestigious Big Eight Conference, Iowa State competes in 20 intercollegiate sports. Overall, Iowa State is consistently ranked among the top intercollegiate athletic programs in the nation, with several Cyclone teams and individuals earning high national rankings and



national championships in recent years.

Iowa State maintains an active intramural sports program, involving nearly 15,000 students each year. The expansive new Recreation/Athletic Complex provides ample space for intramural sports and individual fitness programs for all students, as well as practice and competition areas for several of ISU's intercollegiate teams.

Iowa State is busy working for the future by playing a leading role in revitalizing and modernizing the land-grant mission of education, research and service for the 21st century. Iowa State is a leader in the development of distance education programs to serve the continuing education needs of the people throughout Iowa, the nation and the world. Some of the country's most advanced technology development and technology transfer programs are the result of Iowa State's expanded research programs.

Iowa was the first state in the nation to embrace the land-grant concept in education, and Iowa State has been fulfilling that land-grant mission for Iowa for more than 124 years. It's a university with its roots planted firmly in the rich Iowa soil, and with its eyes focused clearly on the future.

TODAY'S MATCHUP

CYCLONES PLAY HOST TO JAYHAWKS IN HOMECOMING BATTLE

For the fourth time in the last seven years, Iowa State plays host to Kansas for its Homecoming game. Both teams have had extra time to prepare for today's contest. The Cyclones enjoyed an off weekend after playing at Oklahoma Oct. 1, while Kansas lost to Kansas State, 21-13, in front of a national ESPN audience Thursday, Oct. 6.

When Iowa State and Kansas battle on the gridiron, they typically put points on the board. In the past seven meetings, KU has averaged 31.7 points per game, while ISU has tallied 29.9 points.

Kansas leads the series, 38-29-6 overall, and 19-16-3 in Ames. The two schools are 4-4-1 in Cyclone Stadium. Iowa State won five straight games against Kansas from 1985-89.

The Jayhawks' last two games in Ames stand out in the minds of many Cyclone fans. In 1990, Jeff Shudak's 53-yard field goal with 18 seconds remaining forced a 34-34 tie in the another Homecoming game. Two years ago the Jayhawks trailed 47-21 in the third quarter before reeling off 29 unanswered points to win that Homecoming contest, 50-47.

In last year's battle, turnovers killed the Cyclones on a rainy day in Lawrence. ISU fumbled away the football twice inside the KU 10-yard line, was intercepted twice, had a missed field-goal attempt and had a PAT blocked. Jayhawk freshman June Henley broke into the limelight with a school-record 237 yards rushing on 27 carries, scoring three of KU's five touchdowns. Henley broke Kerwin Bell's freshman single-game record of 216 yards.

Iowa State took a 6-0 lead in the first quarter on Calvin Branch's first touchdown of the day, a 40-yard reception from Bob Utter. After Kansas answered with back-to-back touchdowns, true freshman quarterback Todd Doxzon scored his

first career touchdown, throwing a 63-yard strike to Branch to pull Iowa State to within 21-14 with 13:21 left to play. However, Henley tallied his third TD of the day on a 77-yard run 16 seconds later.

James Brooks then took the kickoff a season-long 60 yards to set Iowa State up at the 32. Eight plays later, Branch's 1-yard touchdown run with 8:44 left in the game cut the KU lead to 28-20 before Asheiki Preston's 1-yard touchdown run at the 0:33 mark sealed the Jayhawk victory.

For the day, Preston completed 13 of his 19 passes for 170 yards. Branch led Iowa State with 103 receiving yards and three touchdowns. In the game ISU averaged 6.5 yards per play, but was outgained 480-361.

Cyclone cornerback Marcus Robertson forced a turnover and saved a touchdown as Iowa State used a second quarter comeback to record a 24-20 win in 1989. The game, which was played in Lawrence, featured more than 1,000 yards of total offense, including 411 yards passing for KU quarterback Kelly Donohue, a record in the series between the two schools. Trailing 14-3, ISU scored three times in the second quarter, one a 30-yard dash by running back Blaise Bryant, who wound up with 126 yards on the day. Kansas had a chance to cut into the Cyclone lead when Donohue hooked up with Jim New for 71 yards. But Robertson saved the touchdown by forcing New to fumble on the 1-yard line, and ISU ended up with possession after the ball rolled out of the end zone.

Both coaching staffs in today's game have connections to their respective opponent. Glen Mason was Iowa State's offensive line coach from 1975-76 under Earle Bruce, helping the Cyclones to an 8-3 mark during the 1976 season. During that season, Iowa State was ranked among the nation's top 20 by Associated Press twice and the Cyclones led the Big Eight and were second in the nation in total offense.

Kansas offensive coordinator Golden Pat Ruel was an assistant coach under Jim Walden at Washington State from 1979-81. Ruel and Walden were both assistant coaches at Miami (Fla.) from 1973-76. First-year Iowa State running backs coach Tommie Liggins held the same position at Kansas from 1983-85.

GENE SMITH

Athletics Director — Iowa State University



Promising to make Iowa State "one of the premier athletic programs in the nation," Gene Smith began his tenure as Iowa State's 12th

athletic director on July 1, 1993. He is already making good on that commitment, leading the Iowa State athletic department through success and adversity.

"My goal is to provide a program that wins," said Smith at his initial press conference. "We will do it with integrity, with fiscal integrity, and with a great deal of fire and desire. We will do everything we can to become a dominant force in the Big Eight Conference."

Under Smith, the Iowa State athletic department not only recovered from a devastating flood that struck the state of Iowa, but went forward with implementation of his vision for Cyclone athletics.

In the first 12 months of his tenure, Smith:

- Led a nearly-completed \$8 million drive to finance construction of a new 60,000-square-foot three-story athletic office and training facility.

- Oversaw a \$900,000 project to construct new offices and meeting rooms at Hilton Coliseum for the ISU men's and women's basketball programs.

- Restructured the ISU athletic department management structure to ensure effective communication, fiscal accountability, maximum utilization of resources and a strong commitment to gender equity.

- Created a marketing and promotions department that in its first year, has generated more than \$1 million in corporate commitments to Iowa State athletics, which include state-of-the-art improvements to Cyclone Stadium.

- Hired one of the nation's top young coaches, Tim Floyd, to direct ISU's nationally known men's basketball program.

Smith's strong reputation among his peers was affirmed in June 1994, when the Notre Dame graduate was named president of the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA). Smith also serves on the NCAA President's Commission Liaison Committee.

Prior to his arrival in Ames, Smith served as athletic director at Eastern Michigan University for seven years.

Smith earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Notre Dame in 1977. He won three varsity football letters as a Fighting Irish defensive end, and was a member of the 1973 Associated Press national championship team.

A native of Cleveland, Ohio, Smith has three daughters: Nicole (16), Lindsey (12) and Summer (10).

DR. MARTIN C. JISCHKE

President — Iowa State University



Iowa State University enters its fourth years under the direction of Dr. Martin Jischke. Under his leadership, Iowa State is making

significant progress toward its goal of becoming the nation's premier land-grant university.

Major improvements have been made in Iowa State's undergraduate programs; research programs continue to expand, particularly in agriculture, science and technology; and Iowa State's Extension and technology transfer programs have been reorganized to be more efficient and responsive to the needs of the people of Iowa.

Under the leadership, Iowa State has set new records in several important areas, including:

- Enrollments of minority students, graduate students and high achieving students.

- External funding for research and educational programs, with

\$175.7 million raised in 1993-94.

- Private fund-raising, with the Partnership in Prominence campaign raising \$215 million in the six-year period ending June 30, 1993 and \$61 million in 1993-94.

- Income from intellectual property, with more than \$22 million earned in the past two years.

Jischke, 52, came to ISU from the University of Missouri, Rolla, where he had served as chancellor for five years. He spent 17 years as a faculty member and administrator at the University of Oklahoma, serving as director of the School of Aerospace Mechanical and Nuclear Engineering, Dean of the College of Engineering, and, in 1985, interim president.

A native of Chicago, Jischke earned the B.S. in physics, with honors, in 1963 from the Illinois Institute of Technology, and M.S. in 1964 and Ph.D. in 1968 in aeronautics and astronautics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He is trained as a fluid dynamicist and has expertise in heat transfer, fluid mechanics, aerodynamics, and problems related

to high-speed aircraft and spacecraft. He is the author or co-author of 31 archival journal publications and 21 major technical reports, and is co-editor of a book.

He has served research fellowships with NASA and the Donald W. Douglas Laboratory, and has received research grants from the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Air Force, NASA, the National Institutes of Health, National Severe Storms Laboratory, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. During 1975-76, he served as White House Fellow and Special Assistant to the Secretary of Transportation.

Jischke is a member of the board of directors of the National Association of State Universities and Land-Grant Colleges and the board of trustees of the University Center for Atmospheric Research. In 1993, he received the Centennial Medallion from the American Society of Engineering Education. A leading presidential voice in intercollegiate athletics, he is the 1994-95 chair of the Association of Big 12 Universities.

JIM WALDEN

Head Football Coach — Iowa State University

Eight years ago, the Iowa State administration began a search for a new Cyclone football coach. The quest was not only for a football coach, but for a new direction, a new personality, and a new attitude for the Iowa State program. Iowa State found all those ingredients in Jim Walden. On December 16, 1986, the former Washington State mentor became Iowa State's 28th head football coach. It was a great match.

The 1993 Cyclones, in their second year running the triple-option offense, gained 2,667 yards rushing, the second-highest total in school history. ISU ranked 11th nationally in rushing and second in the Big Eight Conference. Offensive tackle Doug Skartvedt, a Ratcliffe, Iowa, native, became Walden's fourth All-American in four years at Iowa State.

The personable native of Aberdeen, Miss., led his first ISU team finished 3-8 and demonstrated consistent improvement throughout the season. His 1988 team improved to 5-6 and challenged for a winning season. The team finished fifth in the Big Eight Conference and took a 5-5 mark into the final game against Oklahoma State.

Walden recorded a winning season in just his third year at the helm, despite fielding only slightly more than 50 scholarship players throughout most of the 1989 campaign. Iowa State finished 6-5 overall and 4-3 in conference play. His 1989 team ranked 17th nationally in total offense and fielded the Big Eight Conference's offensive leaders in nearly every category.

His 1990 squad tied for fourth place in conference play. The squad highlighted the campaign by recording a 33-31 upset victory at nationally-ranked Oklahoma. The Cyclones recorded over 4,000 yards in total offense for the second consecutive season, and crowned the Big Eight Conference's total offense leader in quarterback Chris Pedersen.

Walden's 1992 squad wrote its name in school's history books as the team that upset No. 7 and Big Eight champion Nebraska. *Sports Illustrated* dubbed the Cyclones' 19-10 win over the Cornhuskers as the biggest upset during the 1992 season.

As the head coach at Washington State for nine years, Walden compiled a 44-52-4 record against tough Pacific-10 Conference competition. During that time, Walden guided teams to three winning seasons and four first-division finishes in the conference. He was one of only two WSU coaches to record more than one winning campaign, and only one other coach in Cougar history won more games or served longer as head coach than Walden.

Walden's Washington State teams became known for the upset victory. No opponent took a WSU team lightly, as the Cougars upset Pac-10 powerhouses USC, UCLA and Washington during his years at the school. In fact, Washington State had great success against intrastate rival Washington, knocking the Huskies off in three of Walden's last five years in Pullman, Wash.

The 56-year-old Walden actually was at Washington State for 10 years, first serving as an assistant to Warren Powers. When Powers left WSU following the 1977 season, Cougar officials tabbed Walden as his replacement. The culmination of a four-year plan came when Walden took the Cougars to the 1981 Holiday Bowl, WSU's first bowl appearance since the 1931 Rose

Bowl. WSU finished the season with an 8-3-1 mark, needing only a win in the regular-season finale to go to the Rose Bowl.

His success did not go unnoticed by his peers. Walden earned Pac-10 Coach-of-the-Year honors in 1981 and 1983. In 1981, he was the UPI West Coast and AFCA/Kodak District IX Coach-of-the-Year.

Despite spending 10 years in the Pac-10, Walden was familiar with Big Eight Conference football. He started his collegiate coaching career in 1969 at Nebraska under his former college coach, Bob Devaney. For the next four seasons, Walden was a defensive coach for the Cornhuskers. During those years, Nebraska won two national championships.

From Nebraska, Walden moved to Miami (Fla.) in 1973 as an offensive backfield coach for Pete Elliott, and was later named defensive coordinator under Carl Selmer. Walden joined Warren Powers' Washington State staff as backfield coach for the 1977 season, and took over the head coaching job in 1978.

SCOUTING REPORT

THE SERIES: Kansas leads the series 38-29-6 with the last ISU victory being a 24-20 decision in 1989. The Jayhawks took advantage of several Cyclone miscues last season in a 35-20 win at Memorial Stadium in Lawrence. ISU fumbled twice inside the Kansas 10-yard line, missed a field goal, had a PAT blocked, and threw two interceptions. The Cyclones had won five straight over Kansas before a 34-34 tie in 1990.

OFFENSIVELY: Kansas returns eight offensive starters from a squad that averaged 214 rushing yards per contest. Through five games this year, the Jayhawks are the ninth-best rushing team in the nation. Paving the way again will be the senior guard tandem of John Jones and Hessler Hempstead. The two have a combined 68 games of starting experience and were both named to the first-team Big Eight list in the coaches poll. Freshman running back June Henley returns after gaining 1,127 yards last season. Henley tallied 321 yards in the first three games before missing the last two games with a shoulder injury. Senior quarterback Asheiki Preston has completed 63 percent of his passes with just two interceptions. The receiving duties will be equally split between Jim Moore and Ahaundai Smith, with George White coming in at flanker occasionally. Kansas has outscored its opponents in the second half by a margin of 92-37.

DEFENSIVELY: The Jayhawks possess the second-best rushing defense in the conference, allowing just 83 yards per contest. The Kansas defense features a strong linebacking corps, led by Ronnie Ward, who has collected a team-high 61 tackles in five games. The Jayhawks boast an experienced secondary as well, returning starters Gerald McBurrows and Tony Blevins. Kwamie Lassiter is another threat at strong safety. Lassiter has 23 tackles and has picked off a pass this season. The Kansas line is young but promising. Steve Harvey has made the switch from linebacker to defensive end and had 23 tackles and a sack to his credit. Defensive tackle Sylvester Wright also has 23 stops and has knocked down two passes. The Jayhawk defense looms toughest at the beginning of each half, allowing just 10 points each thus far in the first and third quarters.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Junior Dorian Brew is the nation's third-leading punt returner with an average of 19.3 yards per return and one touchdown. Freshman placekicker Jeff McCord and punter Darrin Simmons share the kicking duties. Simmons maintains an average of 37.3 yards per boot with a long punt of 52 yards against Texas Christian. June Henley and Ahaundai Smith will return kicks. Smith has two returns for an average of 61 yards, including a 93-yard return for a touchdown against Alabama-Birmingham.

THE COACH: Head coach Glen Mason is in his seventh season at Kansas. Mason is 3-2-1 lifetime versus Iowa State, and guided Kansas to a 5-7 mark last season.

1994 Cy's FAVORITE ALUM

IOWA STATE HONORS RETIRED KENT FEEDS PRESIDENT RICHARD SEVERSON

For over 40 years, Richard Severson has been an extraordinary friend of Iowa State University. The Athletic Department is lauding Severson's dedication and generosity to his alma mater by honoring the recently retired president of Kent Feeds, Inc., as 1994 Cy's Favorite Alum during this weekend's Homecoming celebration.

"I don't think there are many people who are more deserving of this recognition than Rich Severson," said Iowa State Athletic Director Gene Smith. "During my brief tenure here, I've had the opportunity to meet many Cyclone alums, but few embody the spirit and emotion of a true Cyclone fan more than Rich Severson. He is dedicated to the student-athlete and does all that he can to help us to create an environment for them to be successful."

One example of this dedication is his commitment to improving the baseball facilities at Cap Timm Field. Iowa State head baseball coach Bobby Randall has witnessed first-hand Severson's Cardinal and Gold devotion, both through his financial support and his constant friendship.

"He and his wife, Kay, are givers, and they never ask for anything in return," Randall said. "He's really deserving of the recognition as Cy's Favorite Alum. We could name the award after him. He kicked off our baseball fund-raising campaign, and has always been very generous there. But, Rich not only appreciates baseball, he feels that way about every sport at Iowa State."

Severson began his allegiance to Iowa State as a three-time letterwinner on Cap Timm's baseball team. The 1954 team captain is the only Cyclone baseball player ever to collect six hits in one nine-inning game, accomplishing the feat against

Drake on May 10, 1954. He played shortstop for an infield that Timm tabbed "the best fielding unit in the Big Seven" in 1954. Severson organized a reunion of the 1954 team at the Western Michigan football game earlier this fall.

The Kanawha, Iowa, native earned his bachelor of science degree in agronomy in 1954, and then served in the U.S. Air Force as a pilot, attaining the rank of Captain. He joined Kent Feeds in 1957 as a sales trainee and has worked in sales and sales administration, as the Waterloo plant manager, plant operations manager, Vice President - Plant Operations, Executive Vice President - Manufacturing and Distribution, Executive Vice President and General Manager, and President.

He has also served in various capacities as an officer on the boards of other companies related to Kent Feeds, Inc. The company manufactures feed at 12 plants with dealers handling Kent products throughout 13 midwestern states.

In addition to his responsibilities with Kent Feeds, Severson has also served on many community and industry associations. He is a past president of the Muscatine YMCA and was a member of the Muscatine United Way Board of Directors and Executive Committee.

In January 1994, the Iowa chapter of the National Agri-Marketing Association (NAMA) named Severson the Agri-Marketer of the Year. In 1989, he was recognized by the Iowa State University Agriculture Alumni Association as the first recipient of their Professional Award in Agri-Business.

He has served on the American Feed Industry Association's (AFIA) Board of Directors and is a past Chairman of the AFIA, an association



comprised of more than 750 feed manufacturers and allied industry suppliers throughout the United States. He received the Distinguished Service Award from the AFIA in 1993. This award is presented for outstanding leadership and extraordinary contributions to the feed industry and agriculture.

In 1992, Severson became a member of Gamma Sigma Delta, a national honor society in agriculture, in recognition of his leadership and outstanding contributions to agriculture in Iowa.

On September 30, 1994, Severson retired as President of Kent Feeds, Inc., Chairman of the Board of Blue Seal Feeds, Inc., and Senior Vice President of Varied Investments, Inc., the parent company that owns Kent Feeds, Inc., and Blue Seal Feeds, Inc.

Rich and Kay have four daughters, two sons, and six grandchildren. Two daughters, two sons, and two daughters-in-law attended Iowa State University.



STADIUM INFORMATION

First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact the nearest usher to request medical assistance.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked in the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be stamped for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-entry. No pass outs will be allowed between noon and 1 p.m. or one hour before kickoff.

Service for Physicians

Doctors anticipating calls during the game are urged to register at the first aid quarters under the west stands, leaving their exact seat location. The management will see that all calls are delivered without delay.

Lost and Found

A lost and found service is maintained in the Athletic Ticket Office in the Olsen Building at the north end of the stadium. Articles found should be turned over to an usher or left at the Athletic Ticket Office.

Public Telephone

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands.

Iowa State Souvenirs

An attractive array of Iowa State souvenirs are available at conveniently located novelty sales booths throughout the stadium and from vendors in the parking areas.

Coolers, Thermoses Discouraged:

As a courtesy to neighboring guests, spectators are asked NOT to bring stadium chair, coolers, or thermoses into the stands.

Rest Rooms

Restrooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Public Address System

No appeals will be made over the public address system except under extenuating circumstances. The public is asked not to request this service.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 16, 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. Signs are to be displayed on the south end of the Olsen Building. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Associate Athletics Director Elve Everage (129 Olsen Building) before noon on Friday prior to the home games. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Emergency Road Service

Iowa State University and Iowa AAA Motor Club will provide Emergency Road Service for persons attending home football games. This service will be in effect during and within two hours after the game throughout the season. The phone number for the service is 233-6636. Proof of game attendance (ie. ticket stub) may be requested. Basic emergency road service includes starts, tire change, gas delivery and unlocks.

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium any bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located in strategic spots throughout the stadium parking area.

Distractions


We want to make football Saturday a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage you to be respectful of those around you in the stadium. In the event that you feel there is an unreasonable distraction in your seating area, we ask you to take the following steps to help us control undesirable behavior.

- Note the seating section, row, and seat numbers and inform the usher in your section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and request it to stop, if appropriate.

- If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvements of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.

- An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation in next season's ticket assignments.



Meanwhile, independent producers just keep getting better, because they have the freedom to make their own decisions about what's best for their operations.

One of those decisions is how big they want to be. Another is what brand of feed to buy.


