



THIS IS IOWA STATE

ince the first students enrolled at Iowa State, the institution has been committed to academic excellence. Iowa State's reputation for scholarship is internationally known and Iowa State's students are respected as serious scholars.

Iowa State University was founded in 1958 under terms of the Land Grant College Act signed by President Abraham Lincoln during the Civil War. Since the beginning, Iowa State has been a co-educational "people's college." As years passed, the University developed a reputation as an outstanding broad-based institution with academic emphasis in the humanities and the arts, while maintaining its position in the scientific and technical fields. Recently, Iowa State has become known as a leading research center, renowned in the fields of engineering and agriculture.

One of the largest institutions governed by the State Board of Regents, Iowa State is a major Midwestern center of learning for more than 25,000 students, from all 50 states and more than 100 other nations. Iowa State attracts a diverse student body with a wide range of

undergraduate and graduate programs with a student to teaching faculty ration of 18:1. More than 120 undergraduate programs of study are available from Iowa State's eight colleges: Agriculture, Business, Design, Education, Engineering, Family and Consumer Sciences. Liberal Arts and Sciences, and Veterinary Medicine.

The picturesque campus is comfortably situated in a central campus "park" with a splendid combination of conventional and contemporary architecture. ISU's classrooms and buildings are a blend of the old and new, nestled amid thousands of threes and acres of greenery. The modern south campus is dominated by the Iowa State Center, Cyclone Stadium-Jack Trice Field and the


College of Veterinary Medicine.

The Iowa State Center, which boasts one of the nation's finest facilities of its kind, consists of C.Y. Stephens Auditorium, the J.W. Fisher Theater, the Scheman Continuing Education Center, and the James H. Hilton Coliseum. Concert facilities draw some of the top names in entertainment to this Midwestern venue. Paul McCartney, Genesis, U2, Bruce Springsteen, the Rolling Stones, Billy Joel and "Farm Aid 1993" headline the groups that have been featured at the ISU Center.

One of the highlights of the year occurs in Spring as the campus blooms with tulips and apple blossoms just in time for the Veishea celebration. Veishea, which represents the first letters of ISU's original five colleges, is ISU's annual open house and the largest student-run festival in the nation, complete with parade, exhibits and thousands of alumni. The campus is also a breathtaking sight in the fall, when autumn colors and leaves make it a cardinal and gold showplace.

Sports are a vital part of the Iowa State culture. Only one of two schools in the Big Eight to offer 21 sports, Iowa State's program is ranked among the nation's finest. A number of Cyclone intercollegiate teams have been nationally ranked in recent years and several have brought home national titles. The extensive intramural program at ISU boasts one of the highest participation rates in the country.

Cultural and extracurricular activities abound at Iowa State. Students can participate in theater, music, dance and intramural sports, as well as numerous academic and campus organizations. The Greek system is strong, as is the residence hall system. Both have been nationally recognized, along with the top-notch academic advising program.

TODAY'S MATCHUP

Cyclones and Cowboys Battle for First Big Eight Win

s Iowa State celebrates its Homecoming this weekend, the Cyclone football team will be looking for a way to snap its fivegame losing streak against the Oklahoma State Cowboys. Past years have seen close Cyclone-Cowboy clashes with strong efforts on both offense and defense from each squad. Both teams come into today's game winless in conference action.

The Cyclones are looking to bounce back after falling to the Kansas Jayhawks last weekend, 35-20 in Lawrence. Both teams got off to a rough start, with turnovers by each team, but the Cyclones took advantage of a Kansas turnover with quarterback Bob Utter completing a 40-yard touchdown pass to fullback Calvin Branch to take the 6-0 lead. The Kansas offense capitalized on its team's defensive efforts, scoring three touchdowns in the second and third quarters to take the 21-7 lead heading into the last 15:00 of the contest.

However, Iowa State pulled within seven points on a 63-yard touchdown pass from reserve quarterback Todd Doxzon to Calvin Branch with 13:21 left in the game. After Doxzon injured his hand on the touchdown pass, Utter reentered the game to orchestrate a successful 2-point conversion play.

The Jayhawks answered on a score of its own on a 77-yard run by freshman tailback June Henley. The Cyclones never gave up, marching down the field and scoring on a 1yard run by Branch. The extra-point attempt was blocked, but the Cyclones only trailed 28-20. Kansas then took possession and nearly ran out the clock, scoring with:33 seconds left to go in the game to seal the victory.

Turnovers were critical for lowa State, especially two fumbles as the Cyclones approached the KU end zone. Kansas didn't cash in on either fumble, but the Jayhawks stopped sure scores that would have given

Iowa State the advantage.

Doxzon, the true freshman from Omaha, Neb., played for the first time since spraining his ankle in the Rice game. With Doxzon at quarterback in the fourth quarter, the Cyclones gained 102 yards on 13 plays for two scores.

True freshman walk-on Marc Harris made his first appearance as Iowa State's punter against Kansas, kicking four punts for a 41.5 yard average.

Cyclone placekicker Ty Stewart needs just eight points to break into the all-time Cyclone top 10 in scoring. The junior has 125 career points, including 17 points this season with one field goal. A blocked extra-point attempt ended Stewart's string of 44 straight successful PAT tries. He is 14-of-15 in that department this season.

Junior James Brooks, who had missed the Rice and Oklahoma games with a separated shoulder, came back with a flash at Kansas. He returned a punt 42 yards while stepping in for the injured James McMillion, and his 60-yard kickoff return was Iowa State's longest since 1976.

Iowa State defenders continued to be strong as Weylan Harding recorded 15 total tackles, 11 of them unassisted, while Jeff Cole had nine tackles. Offensively, Branch was the standout, scoring all three of the Cyclones' touchdowns including 40 and 60yard touchdown passes from Utter and Doxzon, respectively.

Oklahoma State lost its thirdstraight game last weekend, after Missouri rolled up 493 yards in total offense to OSU's 242 to upend the Cowboys, 42-9. Oklahoma State got on the board first on a 28-yard field goal by placekicker Lawson Vaughn, but the momentum changed quickly as Tiger quarterback Jeff Handy connected on three passes for touchdowns in the first half to give Missouri the lead for good.

The Cowboys' only other score came on a defensive effort by Linc Harden who returned a fumble for 36 yards and the touchdown in the second quarter.

Last season in Stillwater. Oklahoma State took advantage of eight Cyclone turnovers and defeated Iowa State, 27-21. A tremendous defensive effort stopped the Cowboys' first drive forcing them to punt. James McMillion took advantage of it by returning the punt 91 yards for a touchdown. It was Iowa State's only lead of the game as Oklahoma State scored 17 unanswered points in the second quarter to seal the victory.

After this afternoon's contest, the Cyclones will travel to Columbia. Mo. next weekend for a 1 p.m. contest with the Missouri Tigers before returning home, Nov. 6 to play host to Kansas State at 1 p.m.



GENE SMITH

Athletics Director—Iowa State University



romising to make Iowa State "one of the premier athletic programs in the nation," Gene Smith began his tenure as Iowa State's 12th athletics director on July 1, 1993. Prior to his arrival in Ames, Smith served as athletics director at Eastern Michigan University for seven years.

"We want to have winning programs," said Smith. We will do it with integrity, with fiscal integrity, and with a great deal of fire and desire. We will do everything we can to become a dominant force in the Big Eight Conference."

Smith joined the EMU staff in 1983 as assistant athletics director for non-revenue sports. He was named interim executive athletics director in 1985 and was elevated to the position permanently on June 25,

While at Eastern Michigan, Smith guided EMU to unprecedented athletic success. In 1987-88, Eastern

won its first-even Mid-American Conference football and basketball championships, while also winning the California Bowl in football and making its initial appearance in the NCAA Basketball "Sweet 16."

In 1991, Smith was appointed to a four-year term on the 32-member executive committee of the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA). He was recently elected second vice president of the NACDA and will be president of the organization during the 1995-96 academic year.

Under his direction, Eastern Michigan made great strides in facility improvements. New football, basketball, and administrative offices were built with other coaches' offices renovated at that time. Smith also oversaw major renovations at Rynearson Football Stadium. The \$15-million project began in 1991 with the installation of a new game field, and continued through the summer of 1992.

Smith earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from Notre Dame in 1977. He earned three varsity letters as a defensive end, and was a member of the 1973 Associated Press national championship team. The Cleveland, Ohio, native, served as an assistant football coach at Notre Dame from 1977-1981. He then worked two years as a marketing representative for IBM prior to joining Eastern Michigan in April 1983.

DR. MARTIN C. JISCHKE

President—lowa State University



owa State enters its third year under the direction of Dr. Martin Jischke. Under his leadership, Iowa State is making significant progress toward its goal of becoming the nation's premier land-grant university.

Major improvements have been made in Iowa State's undergraduate programs; research programs continue to expand, particularly in agriculture, science and technology: and Iowa State's Extension and technology transfer programs have been reorganized to be more efficient and responsive to the needs of the people of Iowa.

Under Jischke's leadership, Iowa State has set new records in several important areas, including:

- · Minority and graduate enrollments. while undergraduate enrollment remains strong, both in numbers and quality.
- ·External funding for research and educational programs, with \$140 million raised in 1991-92
- ·Private fund-raising, with the Partnership in Prominence campaign raising \$200 million in the five-year period ending June 30,
- ·Income from intellectual property, with more than \$12 million earned in 1992-93

Jischke, 51, came to ISU from the University of Missouri, Rolla, where he had served as chancellor for five years. He spent 17 years as a faculty member and administrator at the University of Oklahoma, serving as director of the School of Aerospace Mechanical and Nuclear Engineering, Dean of the College of Engineering, and, in 1985, interim

president.

A native of Chicago, Jischke earned the B.S. in physics, with honors, in 1963 from the Illinois Institute of Technology, and M.S. in 1964 and Ph.D. in 1968 in aeronautics and astronautics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He is trained as a fluid dynamicist and has expertise in heat transfer, fluid mechanics. aerodynamics, and problems related to high-speed aircraft and spacecraft. He is the author or co-author of 31 archival journal publications and 21 major technical reports, and is coeditor of a book

He has served research fellowships with NASA and the Donald W. Douglas Laboratory, and has received research grants from the National Science Foundation. the U.S. Air Force, NASA, the National Institutes of Health. National Severe Storms Laboratory, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. During 1975-76, he served as White House Fellow and Special Assistant to the Secretary of Transportation.

Jischke and his wife, Patty, have two children, Charles, 16, and Mary, 12.







even years ago, the Iowa State administration began a search for a new Cyclone football coach. The quest was not only for a football coach, but for a new direction, a new personality, and a new attitude for the Iowa State program. Iowa State found all those ingredients in Jim Walden. On December 16, 1986, the former Washington State mentor became Iowa State's 28th head football coach.

The personable native of Aberdeen, Miss., arrived at ISU with "no magic formulas," just a promise to "come in here and do the best I can, to work as hard as I know how." A glance at Walden's coaching record shows that his best has led to some of the most exciting upsets in collegiate football.



Walden's 1992 squad has written its name in the school's history books as the team that upset No. 7 and Big Eight champion Nebraska. Sports Illustrated dubbed the Cyclones' win over the Cornhuskers as the biggest upset during the 1992 season. Under the direction of senior quarterback Marvin Seiler, making his first-ever start in his final home game, Iowa State out-gained the Huskers 399-246. The Iowa State defense held Nebraska's rushing attack, which came into the game leading the nation with an average of 351.1 yards per game, to 192 yards on 39 carries as the Cyclones beat Nebraska, 19-10, for its first win in

the series since 1977.

Although hampered by
numerous injuries to key players, the
1990 Walden squad highlighted the
campaign by recording a 33-31 upset
victory at nationally-ranked
Oklahoma. The team, which tied for
fourth place in conference play,
recorded over 4,000 yards in total
offense for the second consecutive
season, and crowned the league's
total offense leader in quarterback
Chris Pedersen.

His 1989 team ranked 17th nationally in total offense and fielded the Big Eight Conference's offensive leaders in nearly every category. Junior running back Blaise Bryant led all Big Eight players in rushing, scoring, and all-purpose running, while senior Bret Oberg led the league in passing completion percentage. Oberg paced the league in passing completion percentage, total offense, and ranked among the nation's top 10 in passing efficiency. Both athletes set numerous ISU records, and Oberg smashed the Big Eight Conference career passing completion percentage record. Bryant and tight end Mike Busch were selected to All-America teams.

As the head coach at Washington State for nine years (1978-86), Walden compiled a 44-52-4 record against tough Pacific-10 Conference competition. During that time, Walden guided teams to three winning seasons and four



upper-division finishes in the conference.

Walden's Washington State teams became known for the upset victory. No opponent took a WSU team lightly, as the Cougars upset Pac-10 powerhouses USC, UCLA, and Washington during his years at the school. In fact, Washington State had great success against intrastate rival Washington, knocking the Huskies off in three of Walden's last five years in Pullman, Wash.

The 55-year-old Walden actually was at Washington State for 10 years, first serving as an assistant to Warren Powers during the 1977 season.

Despite spending 10 years in the Pac-10, Walden was familiar with Big Eight Conference football. He was a defensive coach for Nebraska under his former college coach, Bob Devaney, from 1969 through 1973. From Nebraska, Walden moved to Miami (Fla.) in 1973 to serve as an assistant under Pete Elliott and Carl Selmer until he moved to Washington State in 1977.

SCOUTING REPORT

THE SERIES: Today's game is the 35th meeting between Oklahoma State and Iowa State, with the Cowboys holding a 20-12-2 advantage. OSU has a 7-2-1 record in games played at Cyclone Stadium. Last season in Stillwater, eight Cyclone turnovers proved costly as the Cowboys defeated ISU, 27-21. In that game, James McMillion ran Oklahoma State's first punt back 91 yards for a touchdown. It was Iowa State's only lead in the game as the Cowboys scored 17 unanswered second quarter points to take clain the victory. The Cyclones' last victory in the series was a 31-21 win in 1989 at Stillwater.

OFFENSIVELY: Oklahoma State returns all starters from a year ago, including flanker Shannon Culver, the Cowboys' leading receiver and the Big Eight's Offensive Newcomer-of-the-Year last season. Culver leads OSU in receiving this year with 18 receptions for 283 yards and one touchdown. The quarterbacking duties are shared between true freshman Tone' Jones and sophomore Gary Porter. Jones leads the team in passing yardage with 514. Porter has 337 yards passing and two touchdowns.

DEFENSIVELY: The defense is led by three all-Big Eight performers. Senior Jason Gildon is the leader of the OSU defense. The three-time all-Big Eight defensive end became the Cowboy career record holder in sacks earlier this season. His 34 sacks moved him past former OSU standout, Leslie O'Neal, currently an All-Pro for the San Diego Chargers. Also returning is linebacker Keith Burns. Burns, a senior, was the 1992 Big Eight Defensive Newcomer of the Year. Senior Scott Harmon returns at strong safety with 12 career interceptions.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Sophomore placekicker Lawson Vaughn leads the team in scoring with 34 points. The native of Edmond, Okla. is perfect on PAT's at 13-of-13. Vaughn is also 7-of-7 in field goal attempts, his longest from 42 yards out. Senior Scott Tyner returns to his punting duties. The 1992 honorable mention all-Big Eight punter is averaging 45.1 yards on 41 punts this season with a long of 67 yards.

THE COACH: Pat Jones is in his 10th season as head coach of the Cowboys. He has a career record of 59-48-2. Earlier this season, in a 27-22 win over Texas Christian, Jones passed Jim Lookabaugh to become the winningest head football coach in Oklahoma State history. Under the guidance of Jones, OSU has appeared in more bowl games (four, including a 3-1 record) than under any other coach at the school. Jones was last year's Big Eight Coach-of-the-Year. He also recorded that honor in 1984. The 1969 graduate of Arkansas was also the National Coach-of-the-Year in 1984 after leading the Cowboys to a 10-2 record.



STADIUM INFORMATION

First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact the nearest usher to request medical assistance.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked at the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be stamped for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for readmission. No pass outs will be allowed between noon and 1 p.m. or one hour before kickoff.

Service for Physicians

Doctors anticipating calls during the game are urged to register at the first aid quarters under the west stands, leaving their exact seat location. The management will see that all calls are delivered without delay.

Lost and Found

A lost and found service is maintained in the Athletic Ticket Office in the Olsen Building at the north end of the stadium. Articles found should be turned over to an usher or left at the Athletic Ticket Office.

Refreshments

Refreshments are served in the stands and at locations around the stadium.

Public Telephone

Pay Telephones are located behind the east and west stands.

Iowa State Souvenirs

An attractive array of Iowa State souvenirs are available at conveniently located novelty sales booths throughout the stadium and from vendors in the parking areas.

Special Medical Needs

Individuals with specific medical needs may request a waiver from the ISU Business Office. Direct all requests to Bill Goldring, Assistant Athletics Director-Business, Room 137, Olsen Building, Ames, IA 50011. (515) 294-4950.

Coolers, Thermoses Discouraged

As a courtesy to neighboring guests, spectators are asked NOT to bring stadium chairs, coolers, or thermoses into the stands.

Rest Rooms

Restrooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Public Address System

No appeals will be made over the public address system except under extenuating circumstances. The public is asked not to request this service.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 16, 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts.

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium any bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team.



Stadium Sign Policy

Signs are to be displayed on the south end of the Olsen Building and on the walls of the stands, both upper and lower decks. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Associate Athletics Director Dave Cox (129 Olsen Building) before noon on Friday prior to the home games. The athletic department reserves the right to more or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.




Emergency Road Service

Iowa State University and Iowa AAA Motor Club will provide Emergency Road Service for persons attending home football games. This service will be in effect during and within two hours after the game throughout the season. The phone number for the service is 233-6636. Proof of game attendance (ie. ticket stub) may be requested. Basic emergency road service includes starts, tire change, gas delivery, and unlocks.

Distractions

We want to make football Saturday a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage you to be respectful of those around you in the stadium. This attitude of cooperation can help to insure a pleasant enthusiastic game atmosphere. In the event that you feel there is unreasonable distraction in your seating area, we ask you to take the following steps to help us control undesirable behavior.

- •Note the seating section, row, and seat numbers, and inform the usher in your section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and request it to stop, if appropriate.
- If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvement of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.
- An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation in next season's ticket assignment.





The laboratory provides teaching and research opportunities for ISU faculty and students, using the most modern equipment available. The Engels also donated a grand piano to the ISU Department of Music.

Although the Engels' gifts have been spread throughout campus, Kathryn's loyalty to the Iowa State Department of Intercollegiate Athletics is without question. In the past year, she contributed \$100,000 in scholarship funds to permanently endow the free safety position on the Cyclone football team.

The most recent expression of her love for Iowa State athletics helped launch the James H. Hilton Coliseum expansion project that will construct new offices and meeting rooms for the Cyclone men's and women's basketball programs.

Kathryn's cash donation of \$345,000 will be combined with other funds to build the addition, which will include team meeting and study rooms, on the east side of Hilton. Space also will be remodeled in the first-floor locker room area to provide training and weight room facilities for both teams.

For the first time ever, both men's and women's basketball coaching staffs will have offices and locker rooms located in Hilton Coliseum. Engel's gift anchored a \$900,000 project to provide equal facilities for both Cyclone teams, and furthers the school's commitment to Title XI, a federal law requiring comparable opportunities and facilities for men's and women's athletic teams.

"Kathryn Engel has made so many dreams come true in such a short period of time," said Iowa State women's basketball coach Theresa Becker. "How special and unique that a woman is helping women's athletics grow here at Iowa State. She truly does define what a land-grant institution is all about."

When reminded of the many ways that she has helped Iowa State throughout the years, Kathryn once again underscored her loyalty to the Cardinal and Gold.

"I am proud to be able to use Ray's money in ways that help the University that he loved," said Kathryn.

Kathryn taught elementary education in Melbourne, Beaman and Marshalltown for 18 years, retiring when she married Ray in 1958. Her son, Dale Johnson, holds two engineering degrees from Iowa State (B.S. 1960; M.S. 1964), and was a member of the Cyclone basketball team in the late 1950s. He now is the Director of Engineering at 3M in St. Paul, Minn. Engel has three granddaughters, Beth, Jean and Julie.

Today also carries a special significance for Kathryn since her husband was honored as Cy's Favorite Alum in 1982.

Since she was a young child, Kathryn Engel has been involved in athletics. She played girls' basketball in high school, in addition to following her brothers in their athletic pursuits. Her love for athletics continues today as Kathryn is an avid golfer, as well as loyal Cyclone fan.

"Kathryn Engel's contribution to Iowa State University and particularly Intercollegiate Athletics, is representative of the generosity needed to provide student-athletes the educational experience to prepare them for tomorrow's complex society," said Athletics Director Gene Smith. "She is a warm, loving individual that the Cyclones should always hold dear to their hearts. As a recipient of the 1993 Cy's Favorite Alum award, we will be able to properly recognize her generosity."
