A lecture by Dr. Rodolfo Acuna Chairman-Chicano Studies Department California State University at Northridge

The presentation by Dr. Acuna will cover the history of the Chicano Studies Movement and will also focus on the recent California decision in the "BAKKE" Case. The Courts decision will have serious implications for minorities in higher education throughout the United States. At this point the case seems headed for a Supreme Court ruling.

Dr. Acuña has authored five books, Story of the Mexican American: The Men and the Land (1969); A Mexican American Chronical (1970); Occupied America (1972); and Sonoran Caudillo: The Time of Ignacio Pesqueira.

He is also the current and founding chairman of the Chicano Studies Department at California State University at Northridge. He is the Chief Architect of the largest Ethnic Studies Program in the country.
