The International Students Council will hold its International Week 1990 October 21 to 26 to coincide with Ames schools Global Awareness Week. The objective of our event is to promote an appreciation and awareness of the various cultures present in the Iowa State University /Ames community. This year our focus will be on **Women of the World**.

International Week 1990 will feature the following events:

1. **Global Food Fest** - Sunday October 21 at 1:00 pm in the Great Hall, Memorial Union (M.U.) The mayor of the City of Ames will be the honored guest. Food from various countries will be available for very affordable prices. Tickets to the event will be sold at the Margaret Sloss House (Women's Center), YWCA (Alumni Hall Rm. 15), the booths in M.U. and the Hub, the week of October 15 - 19. Ticket prices are \$1.00 for anyone over 12 years and \$0.50 for ages 6 - 12. T-shirts and sweat shirts will also be available
2. **Panel Discussions, Film Shows and Slide Shows** - October 21 - 26 These events will focus on Women of the World and will be held during the week in the M.U. Programs will be available from October 15. Admission is free.
3. **World Culture Display** - Friday October 26, from 1:00 to 5:00 pm in the Great Hall M.U. - This is a display of cultural items, musical instruments and art work from many countries. This event is specifically designed to expose the ISU/Ames community to the cultures of the world. Admission is free.
4. **Kaleidoscope of Culture** - Friday October 26, from 7:30 pm to midnight in the Great Hall, M.U.- This grand finale event will feature cultural performances of dance and music from various countries of the world. Refreshments will be served and admission is free.
