Goal: To build active and lasting friendship based on mutual understanding between the people of the United States and China.

Toward that end we urge the establishment of full diplomatic, trade,
and cultural relations between the two
governments according to the
principles agreed upon in the joint
U.S.-China communique of Feb. 28,
1972, and that U.S. foreign policy
with respect to China be guided by
these same principles: respect for
sovereignty and territorial integrity;
non-aggression; non-interference in
the internal affairs of other states;
equality and mutual benefit; and peaceful co-existence.

We also call for the removal of all barriers to the growing friendship and exchange between our two people. We recognize that a major barrier is the presence of U.S. armed forces in Taiwan, a province of China.

Activities of the local Association:
To distribute literature, films and photo exhibits; to sponsor speakers and study classes; to speak out against distortions and misconceptions about the People's Republic of China; to publish a newspaper and pamphlets; to promote the exchange of visitors as well as technical, cultural and social experiences.

In each activity to pay special attention to those issues of greatest concern to the people of the United States.

Everyone is invited to participate in our activities and anyone who agrees with our goal is welcome to join.
