Brief Report: (accomplishments, items discussed, goals, and future projects)

We were asked whether to recommend to President Eaton and the Board of Regents to name Old Botany Hall after distinguished alumna, Carrie Chapman Catt, once the building has been renovated. The vote was unanimous in favor of recommending the naming of this particular building after Catt provided that the renovations will be done. If the necessary repairs are not completed to reopen this building then we would suggest that another building be named after her.

After we discussed and voted on the Carrie Chapman Catt issue, Dean Lagmarano (our chairperson) announced that President Eaton has now declared a moratorium on discussing the naming of any other University buildings, streets, etc. until our committee has reviewed and revised the current naming policy. A subcommittee will meet and then report to our entire committee early next semester and we will discuss this in further detail. Until then we will not consider suggesting anything else to be named.
