
Some Lee County W P A Projects



In planning employment for the 830 men and women certified relief workers, Lee county and town officials, together with community leaders, spensored a number of practical WPA work projects as indicated on the above map. Foremost is the construction and improvement of 120 miles of Farm-to-Market roads, including grading, bridging and surfacing, scheduled for completion by next spring. WPA has also improved three miles of city streets and alleys, opened a rock quarry, repaired school buildings, built a 4100 foot recreational river front at Fort Madison and an athletic field with bleachers at Keokuk. WPA has also constructed sewers, operated two large sewingrooms to provide clothing for destitute families, and conducted surplus commodity surveys, traffic surveys, nursery schools and given library assistance.
